Conventions	There are no spelling, punctuation, or grammar errors.	There are 1-2 spelling, punctuation, or grammar errors.	There are 3-5 spelling, punctuation, or grammar errors.	There are 5 or more spelling, punctuation, or grammar errors.
Presentation	Final draft is clean, neat, attractive; typed and double spaced; handed in on time	Final draft is mostly clean, neat, attractive; typed and double spaced; handed in a day late	Final draft is somewhat clean, neat, attractive; typed and double spaced; handed in 2 days late	Final draft is not clean, neat, or attractive; handed in more than 2 days late.
